## **Traditional Choice - £3,495**

The Traditional Choice provides all of those elements that you would have come to expect from a traditional funeral, with services conducted at either Kent & Sussex crematorium, or at Wealden crematorium.

Traditional Choice includes:

- Collecting the deceased within a 15-mile radius\*\* and bringing them into our care. There is an additional cost of £150 for collecting someone out of hours – between 6pm and 8am, on weekends or Bank Holidays
- Gentle and sensitive care of the deceased, including washing them and dressing them in the clothes of your choice
- Providing a veneer coffin
- As part of our professional service throughout the arrangements, dealing with all the legal and medical administrative paperwork
- Visiting the deceased person once by appointment during office hours
- Creating a dedicated online memorial page, including an online donation option
- Providing a celebrant or minister to conduct the service
- Attendance of the Funeral Director
- Conveying the deceased to the local crematorium, in a traditional hearse, with the provision of four pallbearers

The Unattended Choice provides you with a simple, dignified cremation, without the attendance of family or friends. It does allow for a memorial or alternative celebration, this can be held wherever and however you choose – without the constraints or fuss of a church or crematorium service.

Unattended Choice includes:

- Collecting the deceased within a 15-mile radius\*\* and bringing them into our care. There is an additional cost of £150 for collecting someone out of hours – between 6pm and 8am, on weekends or Bank Holidays.
- Meeting with you and assisting you with all the legal and medical administrative paperwork
- Providing a veneer coffin
- Conveying the deceased to the local crematorium, in a private vehicle
- Crematorium fee
- Collecting the ashes and returning them to you in a suitable container

Disbursements are fees charged at cost, which we pay to other third parties on your behalf. They include items such as the crematorium, cemetery, flowers etc.

Payment terms.

We require a 50% deposit 3 days prior to the funeral taking place. The final invoice is sent to you following the funeral and full settlement of the account is requested within 30 days of the date of the funeral. For the unattended choice cost is payable in full 3 days prior to the funeral taking place.
